Situation Summary: AS A RESULT OF FLOODING JULY 7-8, FEMA REGION III REQUESTED ACTIVATION OF ESF#1 ON 7/10 TO PROVIDE STAFF TO SUPPORT DFO OPERATIONS IN CROSS LANES, WV, AND STAFF TO SUPPORT THE RAPID NEEDS ASSESSMENT TEAM. ESF #1 FHWA WV STAFF REPORTED ON 7/10 TO THE DFO. THE ALT RETREP REPORTED ON 7/11 TO THE DFO AND ASSUMED THE ROLE OF ESF#1 TEAM LEADER. STAFF FROM OET REPORTED ON 7/11 TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL DFO SUPPORT. THE RNAT IS PRESENTLY CONDUCTING AERIAL SURVEILLANCE VIA HELO. FHWA WV COORDINATED WITH WV DOT IN PROVIDING HIGHWAY DAMAGE INFORMATION. COORDINATION OCCURRED WITH USCG, FAA, AND FRA IN PROVIDING WATER, AIR, AND RAIL REPORTS. ESF#1 COORDINATED WITH ESF#5 AND PROVIDED AN INFRASTRUCTURE SUMMARY. ESF#1 HAS RECEIVED NO MISSION ASSIGNMENT TASKINGS AS OF THIS TIME.

TRANSPORTATION IMPACT

Air: AIR CARRIER AIRPORTS ARE OPERATING NORMAL AT THIS TIME.

Rail: CSX HAS CONTRACTORS WORKING ON DAMAGE BETWEEN QUINNIMONT AND MONTGOMERY. THE MAINLINE ALONG THE NEW RIVER IS EXPECTED TO RETURN TO SERVICE WITH REDUCED SPEEDS BY THURSDAY NIGHT. THIS AFFECTED A 35 MILE SECTION WHERE TRACK WAS WASHED OUT OR MUD SLIDES COMPROMISED RIGHT OF WAY.

NORFOLK SOUTHERN IS ALL BACK IN SERVICE EXCEPT BETWEEN MULLENS AND DEEPWATER. RESUMPTION IN THIS AREA IS NOT PREDICTED AT THIS TIME; NOTE: THIS IS A SECONDARY LINE USED BY TWO COAL TRAINS OR LESS DAILY.

Highways: NO INTERSTATES WERE AFFECTED. HOWEVER, NUMEROUS LOCAL ROADS SUFFERED MODERATE OR GREATER DAMAGE.

Marine: ADVISORIES FOR FAST MOVING WATER ON OHIO RIVER
